New Points (Accessories After The Fact)

Sawyer, not known if he was there in the first place  
Failure to search Depository despite eyewitnesses reports  
Brennan not source of 12:45 description  
Norman Jarman Williams went to 4th floor  
WJL admitted "least direct evidence of all" LHO was in window  
Unknown witness (other than Worrell) saw man flee from back of Depository  
Willie Mitchell saw no one in window  
False SS agents at back door and on knoll

Medical testimony against "delayed reaction" omitted from WR  
Trajectory of 45 quoted continuously, suddenly abandoned  
Silence of WC and all others re head snap seen in Zapruder film

WC arbitrarily changed date LHO cashed check A&P from 10/31 to 11/1/63  
All LHO luggage too small to hold rifle even disassembled  
Hump in blanket ~~about~~ 10" vs scope 11", Stombaugh says could not have been made by  
object longer than 10"  
No oil stains, marks, or other evidence rifle was in paper bag  
No oil stains in blanket, though rifle well oiled  
All underestimate length paper bag at about 27"  
Disappearance Studebaker tape on paper bag  
Another paper bag found in Irving Post Office dead letters

Indications that Givens' story 11:55 encounter LHO on 6th floor is perjury and collusion  
Lovely/Shelley affidavits 11/22/63 consistent with Victoria Adams' story, testimony not  
Baker 9/23/64 said LHO "drinking a coke" then deleted phrase; Jenner said same 1967  
Pierce Allman met LHO near front door TSED, i.e., LHO lingered, not "escaped"  
Police searched bus right after LHO departed bus  
Timing taxi ride reduced 11 to 9 to 6 minutes  
Apparent perjury Fbitz/Gerald Hill vs Decker/Brown on link between JFK and JDT suspects  
Unexplained foreknowledge by DPs of LHO's Beckley St. address and Elsbeth St. old address

Misrepresentation by WC of "misidentification" as Mauser and failure show rifle Weitzman  
Serial number rifle not exclusive  
Scope mounted for left-handed man  
Two homemade slings, neither used or traced  
WC failure establish discovery and authenticity ammo clip  
Some markings on 3 shells found TSED not made by Carcano, contrary to WR  
Failure FBI canvass to trace purchase of ammo, ditto, 30 lbs shells collected  
Ammo not recent or current as WR asserts  
Palmprint on rifle may be fabricated; Griffin admitted would have been very, very  
difficult to detect forged evidence by DP or FBI  
No rifle cleaning equipment (ramrod, etc) found LHO possessions anywhere

Chalk mark on stand-in "at point where bullet entered"  
JEH misrepresented significance of 1/13/64 Report on indications exit at front of  
neck--then thought to be exit head fragment  
30 FBI and SS interviews PH personnell suppressed  
Transcript Perry press conference "lost"  
Lacerations pharynx and trachea larger than skin wound, i.e., bullet went front to back  
FBI told Washington Post December 1963 bullet found deep in shoulder  
Sibert/O'Neill rely on path of fragments through brain, do not mention any small  
bullet hole back of head  
Autopsy skull diagram does not show entrance wound head  
Autopsy face sheet arrow shows head bullet traveled to left (instead of to right)  
2 contradictory sizes Connally back wound  
No fabric traces on stretcher bullet  
Spectrographic findings mentioned by R. Frazier indicate lack of identity bullets,  
smears, metallic traces

New Points (Accessories)

WJL admitted WR wrong where says all evidence supports single-bullet theory  
Retraction Shaw's initial opinion (one bullet) suppressed in WR

Bentley, Hill, Carroll, Lyon and Walker, in car with LHO, all failed mention  
Hidell in their contemporaneous reports

JP Johnston listed "O.H. Lee" not Hidell; same in Kantor notes for 11/22/63  
Curry unaware 11/23/63 if LHO ever used Hidell except for P.O. Box order  
LHO had index card for Gus Hall, Vincent T. Lee, and "Hidell"  
Marina Oswald's self-contradictions re use of Hidell

Camera (used to take LHO/rifle photo) not authenticated; not used except for  
self-incrimination (no photos child, friends, scenery)

Hosty's license number could not have been copied by Marina as WR asserts  
FBI was able to intercept LHO outgoing letters  
Marina's lies, and lies about lying  
LHO's deathbed denial of guilt

Tippit's movements, misrepresentation and falsification

Callaway's peculiar question, "which way did he go"

McDonald was holding his own gun when he approached LHO in theater

Harry Olsen near Tippit scene

Jacket NOT found by Westbrook or even in his presence

Descriptions NOT given by Poe but by Summers and R.W. Walker, and not consistent LHO

Indications an automatic was used, and automatic shells found (G. Hill)

Indications Nelson never got 12:45 instruction proceed central Oak Cliff

Indications radio log falsified

Tippit's clipboard

Mary Dowling, LHO and Tippit at Dobbs House together, did "see each other"

Identity of "No. 279 (Unknown)"

Undated note not found by DPs searching books Paine residence 11/23/63  
Walker bullet originally identified as 30.06

Peripheral deaths, 71.5% of total from unnatural causes, vs national average of 10.12%

Arraignment may be falsified (Hicks testimony)

FBI monitored Ruby with visitors 11/24/64

Eric Rogers reported man left with Marina and Ruth Paine

4-week delay in delivery LHO letter to Arnold Johnson

Lawson conversation with SS PRS on names of others in case it was not LHO

LHO had only \$200 when departed for USSR

WC falsified date his departure from London for Helsinki

WC could not account for 6 weeks LHO's life in USSR prior Minsk

Indications Embassy wrote letters in LHO name

LHO filled out two forms applying for return of passport

LHO offered military secrets to US agencies acquired during stay in USSR

LHO went for driver's license test day of Bogard incident

Robert Adrian Taylor did not withdraw ID of LHO contrary to WR

Shasteen corroborated Hitchison story which WR fails to mention

Ruby was police informer

Was seen at DP building 9 a.m. 11/22 or 11/21/63

Was seen at DP building Sunday morning when supposedly at his apt.

Made overnight trip to Havana, fall 1959

Evidence against main street ramp

Evidence tried enter Fritz office during LHO interrogation

Connally hit at frame 238 corroborated by air forced into cheeks.  
Sitzman and the Newmans saw impact at frame 313 at right front of head  
"Echo effect" in fact means shot from knoll would sound like shot from TSEB  
Wire 11/23/63 a.m. to Dallas FBI office says bullet below shoulders, 45-60° trajectory,  
short depth, no exit  
Specter questioned Sibert and O'Neill 3/12/64 for 45 minutes; they stuck by and  
even reinforced their report  
"End of opening could be felt with finger"—i.e., even if location of wound is higher  
than holes in clothes, there is still crucial evidence against bullet transit  
In goat tests, exit invariably larger than entrance, not the reverse (as in JFK per WC)  
Anterior neck wound may be too small even for entrance of 6.5 bullet (3-5 mm vs 10 mm max.)  
Contusions vertical 4-6" at site anterior neck wound, tracheal tear is at right front—  
totally inconsistent with rear to front transit of a bullet  
Connally, frame 238, cheeks puff, hair disarranged, mouth opens (wind knocked out),  
shoulder buckles (32° to 52° in one frame)—all involuntary reactions, ruling  
out "delayed reaction"  
No fibers carried into his back (as in wrist)—i.e., pristine bullet  
Double head movement: forward at 69.6 feet per second, backward at 100.3 fps,  
vs falling body at earth's surface accelerates 32 fps  
Neuromuscular reaction (head snap) ruled out by speed of snap—i.e., eyeblink  
in 40 milliseconds, vs change in direction in 56 milliseconds  
Also: neuromuscular reaction would cause progressive acceleration of head, while  
in fact velocity after frame 314 is constant (classic neuromuscular reaction  
is that body goes limp, not in any direction in particular)  
Bone found 11/23/63 on south side Elm appeared to be from occipital region head; but  
shot from rear could not drive part of rear skull 25 feet to the left  
No. 3 shell has dent in lip, could not have been fired in any rifle 11/22/63  
Missing from No. 3 shell is chambering impression along side, found all other  
shells bullets and test bullets fired from Carcano  
On 4/14/64, Eisenberg memo said CE 399 was not in wrist and Connally hit by 2 bullets  
On 4/21/64, Light and Dolce strongly rejected CE 399 as the wrist missile (Olivier  
withholds opinion pending tests)  
Specter carefully did not ask Light, Olivier, Dzemian if CE 399 could be the single missile  
An additional face sheet "disappeared" between autopsy room and WC files—did Humes burn?  
A WC staff member (WJL) told Life he was "certain" Humes had burned original autopsy  
because it was contrary to the official report  
Specter worked average of 3 and 1/4 days per week (26 hrs) for 10 months @ \$10,719.28  
Jacket: FBI failed to trace "B 9738" or "30 030" marks, although canvassed 424  
establishments in Dallas, Fort Worth, and New Orleans; LHO other apparel had no  
laundry or dry-cleaning marks of any kind?  
3 Dal-Tex women saw 2 men with rifle [11/21/63] 5:10 pm in parking lot behind TSEB  
Carr saw man corresponding with Walthers No. 2 man, Hughes film man in next window,  
Worrell's man escaped rear TSEB, and Craig's man in station wagon  
Robinson also saw man enter station wagon, corresponding Craig's man

Omission and Suppression

"Armed with 30-30 rifle" in 12:45 police alert  
Jarman, thought shots came from below fifth floor  
Norman, disputed FBI report on his statement re source of shots  
Negative medical testimony on Connally's "delayed reaction"  
Boone and Fritz identifications of the rifle as a Mauser  
Negative results of canvass to trace 6.5 WCC ammo to LHO  
Contradictory testimony on rifle in closet  
Contradictory testimony on LHO's rifle practice  
Failure to discover independent evidence of any LHO firing practice  
Shaw retraction of opinion one bullet caused all Connally wounds  
Heindel, knew LHO, was known as "Hidell"  
Piper and Shelley saw LHO on first floor at about noon (not 6th floor)  
Three Tippit bullets withheld by Dallas Police, recovered in surprise raid  
Discrepancies re arraignment of LHO for the assassination (no check-out slip)  
Pugh/Kline allegations LHO under federal surveillance, reported in press, later denied  
Allegations of FBI intimidation by various witnesses (Robert Oswald, Delgado, Andrews)  
Only \$200 in LHO bank account on eve of his defection  
Anachronistic and possibly forged letter received by International Rescue Committee  
FBI interviews of Pizzo (whose identification of Oswald as Bogard's customer  
was firm initially, but later uncertain and dubious)  
FBI interview of Robert Adrian Taylor maintaining identification of Oswald  
Larry Crafard suspected by investigators for Warren Commission as "false Oswald"  
Shasteen's corroboration of Hutchison's story  
Turner's report on conversations with Greener, which is inconsistent with  
Commission's insinuations against Ryder  
Dean Andrews' testimony on Oswald's innocence by reason of lack of marksmanship  
Uncertainty about Oswald's date and time of departure from New Orleans, and  
feasibility of his having visited Mrs. Odio  
Ruby's overnight trip to Havana in the fall of 1959  
Curry's phone was off the hook on the night before Oswald was murdered  
Tasker's testimony, which was incompatible with the Main Street Ramp thesis  
Suspect nature of the stories of four (not three) police officers re: Ruby's  
alleged use of the Main Street ramp  
Griffin's accusations of perjury against Dean and Newman  
Eberhardt's testimony that Ruby was a police informer  
Hansen's testimony that Ruby was at entrance of Dallas Police building at  
9 a.m. on 11/22/63 (or 11/21/63).  
Spears' premature knowledge of Ruby's identity and his attempt to sell this information

Homemade paper bag found in Irving post office dead letter section  
FBI Summary and Supplemental Reports, and Sibert/O'Neill reports, whose  
contents conflict with the autopsy findings  
Photographs showing position of bullet holes in back of clothes  
Thirty or more interviews with Parkland Hospital witnesses, by Secret Service  
and/or FBI  
Spectrographic analysis report on bullets, fragments, smears, and traces  
Autopsy photographs and x-rays  
Original Zapruder film  
Secret emergency meeting described in Gerald Ford's book  
Carolyn Arnold's assertions, placing Oswald on first floor during the crucial

Misrepresentation and misleading statements

Frazier's testimony on cut-off time for Connally shot

Date Oswald cashed check for \$33 at Irving A & P

Bulge in blanket, in relation to rifle scope

Dougherty's testimony that Oswald had nothing in his hands when he entered

Discovery by Captain Fritz that the Tippit and Kennedy suspects were the same man

Mistake "Mauser" made by Seymour Weitzman alone

Rifle C2766 is an accurate weapon

Rifle serial number is exclusive

Ammunition "recent" and "current"

Markings on shells all made by Carcano rifle

Ammunition clip was in rifle when found (unauthenticated)

Perry statements to press, and initial medical opinion, on anterior neck wound

"All the evidence" indicated stretcher bullet could have caused all Connally wounds

Three doctors expressed independent opinion one bullet caused all Connally wounds

No real Hidell found

Only one negative of photograph of Oswald with rifle was found

Explanation of how Hosty's auto license number got into Oswald's notebook

Lineups were "fair"

Oswald and Tippit had never seen each other

Source of description of Tippit's killer on police radio

Identity of the police officer who found the jacket

Oswald departed from London on October 9th, 1959 (actually October 10th)

Records establish that Oswald was in Moscow during six "missing" weeks

Have/Have Not (two forms were filled in by Oswald)

Oswald's supposed inability to drive a car as of 11/9/63

Robert Adrian Taylor's alleged retraction of his identification of Oswald

Ruby was not present, as reported, at Homicide door late Friday afternoon

Three TV technicians who saw Ruby outside police building Sunday morning "mistaken"

## Delayed and externally compelled investigations

Bullet mark on curb and Tague cut, July/August  
Palmprint on rifle, September  
MacDonald suicide, several months

## Failure to investigate

Secret Service agents reported at scene  
Disappearance protective tape on fingerprints paper bag; removal of Stemmons' sign  
Failure discover LHO clipboard for about a week though conspicuous  
Milton Jones' allegation police mounted and searched bus  
Conflicting testimony ("there he sits") Fritz/Hill vs Brown/Decker  
Dad not show Carcano to Weitzman to identify  
Disappearances all trace of palmprint lift on rifle barrel  
Validity of palmprint lift (Mercader effect)  
Sibert/O'Neill observations at autopsy  
References to "Hidell" on 11/22/63 (if not, why not?)  
Allegation photo LHO with rifle developed at 501 Elm  
Asserted intimidation attempts by Hosty, INS, of Marina Oswald  
Possible mail cover on LHO post office boxes  
Rumor Tippit involved narcotics traffic  
Other witnesses to Tippit shooting (Wrights, Clemons, McCravey, etc.)  
Callaway's question "which way?" conflicting his alleged observation fleeing killer  
McDonald by-line story he was holding his gun when approached LHO in theater  
Contents Tippit's clipboard  
Radio log references to automatic pistol and shells  
Overlooking and later discovery (by whom?) of undated note  
Coincidence between Munich "fabrication" and Marina Oswald's account of Walker shooting  
Apparent poisoning of dog next door to General Walker  
Reynolds and MacDonald misadventures  
Deaths of some eight witnesses during active investigation  
Hicks' failure confirm arraignment of Oswald  
Man reported by Eric Rogers (left New Orleans with the Oswald and Paine women)  
4-week delay in transit LHO letter to Arnold Johnson, and handwriting discrepancies  
Various allegations intimidation by FBI  
Laundry number on jacket found at Tippit scene  
Origin of rifle obtained in barter by Robert Adrian Taylor  
Passport Office indifference to cancellation LHO prior passport, though explicitly indicated  
Office of Naval Intelligence failure to question or prosecute LHO  
Seeley's inaction (not pressed)  
Source of Hudkins, Goulden stories re LHO on FBI payroll  
Mistaken identity in cases of alleged contacts with LHO  
Guthrie and Lt. Butler re Ruby involvement in bribery; Tom Howard re presence in DP basement  
Confusion re Ruby's address  
Ruby's role as police informer  
Unidentified newspaperman, possibly mistaken for Ruby by TV technicians



## Manipulation or distortion

"Most probably" Brennan was the source of the 12:45 description (he was not the source)  
Evidence placing LHO at window was actually very weak, as Liebeler has conceded  
Rowland's alleged lack of credibility  
Holland's testimony (he himself claims it was watered down)  
"Heavy bag" (Randle said heavy paper)  
"Subsequently" was actually "late in November" (discovery of blue jacket)  
Traffic conditions as argument against Ruby's presence at Parkland  
Responsibility for alleged misidentification of the rifle (Boone and Fritz omitted)  
Publication in Exhibits of photographs which do not show bullet holes in JFK clothing  
Trajectory of 45° cited repeatedly, later transformed into 17°  
Initial medical opinion on nature of anterior neck wound, and press inaccuracy  
Frames 314 and 315 transposed, converting backward movement into forward movement  
So-called independent opinion of 3 Parkland doctors that one bullet caused all  
of the Governor's wounds, when at least one doctor retracted that opinion  
All the evidence indicated that CE 399 could have caused all the wounds, when in  
fact all the evidence indicated the exact reverse  
Implicit claim that Marina copied Hosty's license number, when manifestly she could not have  
Solicitation of affidavits from Kelley and Sorrels to counter testimony from Holmes and  
another witness that Oswald did freely give information on his trip to Mexico City  
Solicitation of testimony from Anderson and Zahm to counter Folsom testimony and other  
evidence that LHO was a poor shot  
"Fairness" of glaringly unfair lineups  
The 12:45 instruction to Tippit to move into central Oak Cliff, endorsed the dubious  
and suspect  
Assertion that LHO and Tippit had never seen each other, omitting Dobbs House  
Assertion Poe was source of the description of the Tippit killer (actually R.W. Walker  
and Summers)  
Failure of Tippit witnesses to identify LHO's shirt  
"Have/Have Not" on passport application: LHO actually filled out 2 different forms  
Alleged normalcy of State Department transactions in re: LHO and Marina  
Secret emergency meeting described in Ford's book suppressed in WR  
LHO's driving ability on date of auto demonstration  
Alleged retraction by Robert Adrian Taylor of his ID of LHO (barter of rifle)  
Impeachment of disinterested witnesses in 2-Oswalds episodes  
Lumping of the credible testimony of Homer and Sterling Wood with implausible  
testimony of other witnesses, concealing importance of the Woods' story  
Lemonade incident used to disqualify ID of LHO, when in fact it supports the ID  
Dates of Odio visit; and "evidence" that LHO was on specific bus New Orleans to Houston  
Innocence and frequency of Ruby's trips to Havana 1959  
Kantor/Tice credibility re Ruby's presence at Parkland  
"Small number" did not have credentials checked was actually 31%  
Suspect testimony of 4 (not 3) police officers who supported Main St. Ramp allegation  
Silence on Griffin's accusations against 2 policemen (Dean and Newman) as perjurers  
Euphemism of "abortive transfer"  
Extent of Ruby's friendships with policemen  
Ruby's attempt to enter Homicide office  
Credibility of testimony placing Ruby at police building early Sunday morning  
Ruby's activities: omission of testimony relating to Friday morning

## Inattention to evidence

Sawyer's statement "not known if (the assassin) was there in the first place"  
Norman/Jarman/Williams went to fourth floor (not sixth) before going to street  
Eunice's report about an unknown witness who saw a man run out the back of the TSBD  
Sorrells' strange lack of interest in Julia Mercer's story, because "rifle found"  
"Secret Service" agents on the scene, who could not be legitimate  
Hudson testimony that Stemmons sign had been moved, then removed entirely  
Evidence of prior LHO Thursday visit to Irving  
Wildly conflicting evidence on chicken remains  
Fingerprints, or lack of fingerprints, on cartons in shield of cartons  
Tape dispenser dispensed wet tape  
Disappearance of scotch tape placed on long paper bag to preserve fingerprint  
Paper bag found in Irving dead-letter section  
Belated discovery of clipboard, in conspicuous position on sixth floor  
Alleged search of bus by police  
Bledsoe testimony on the arrest of a different suspect  
Use of LHO's old Elsbeth Street address on police list at TSBD with indication he was  
    contacted and okay  
Boone's written reports identifying rifle as a Mauser  
Change of rifle sling, and source of straps used  
Possibility that palmprint on rifle was fabricated evidence  
Two different sizes given for Connally wound (1.2" vs 3/5")  
Absence any mention of Hidell on 11/22/63  
Contradictory accounts by Marina on LHO use of alias  
Possible third photo of LHO with rifle, described by Marguerite Oswald  
Kantor entry indicating LHO/rifle photo developed at 501 Elm  
Robert Oswald's testimony that Hosty threatened and intimidated Marina  
Indications that FBI maintained mail cover on LHO (knew contents his outgoing letter)  
LHO's deathbed denial and his earlier statements he was being framed  
Tippit's working at home at night (unlisted phone)  
Glen King's statements, 3 shots (instead of 4)  
Extraordinary solicitude of dispatcher for Tippit--4 signals in 23 minutes  
Evidence both Tippit and LHO at Dobbs House at same time  
Indications of automatic revolver and automatic shells at Tippit scene  
Inconsistent descriptions of jacket  
Identity of No. 279 (Unknown)  
Contradictions in testimony on discovery of jacket  
Police search of books but failure to find undated note  
Contents undated note inconsistent with Marina's explanation  
Illness of dog next door  
Allegation Walter Kirk Coleman warned not to talk  
Wurry vs FBI on monitoring of suspects' conversations with visitors  
Lawson testimony indicating PRS did have names of Dallas suspects  
Indications of intimidation of witnesses by FBI (Delgado, Litchfield, Bogard)  
Butler self-contradictions on Ruby involvement attempt bribe Guthrie

Bias and predisposition

Considered only Depository in accounting for source mark on curb, Tague cut  
Favorable toward Brennan, self-admitted liar; unfavorable toward Worrell, who  
reported man fleeing from rear of TSED

Impeached Rowland, but ignored manifest police perjury and concealed Griffin  
accusations against Dean, Newman of perjury

Interpretation of Zapruder film as consistent with lone assassin

Finding that lineups were fair, despite contrary evidence

LHO had enough time despite traffic, Ruby did not because of traffic

Accepted Marina's account of Walker shooting, despite large body contrary evidence

Accepted single-missile, lone-assassin theories despite massive contrary evidence

Impeachment of witnesses (Bogard, Rowland, Hunter, Whitworth, Ryder, etc.)

Rejection of Kantor/Tice testimony

Use of euphemism "abortive transfer"

Accepted Butler denial, vs Guthrie assertions Ruby involved attempt bribe him

## Illogic and double standard

- Thesis that a fragment from the 313 head shot traveled 260 feet to hit curb, while other fragments same bullet dropped gently into car
- Denial that Hughes film showed 2 men in window, boxes only, and indifference to fact it failed show LHO in window
- Thesis of "delayed reaction" to wounds in vital organs causing involuntary reaction
- Conclusion that shield of cartons needed for concealment when pillars, cartons already on sixth floor provided built-in shield
- Acceptance of Bledsoe testimony LHO had no jacket, vs three other witnesses who said he was wearing a jacket
- Circular reasoning on purchase and possession of ammunition, established only by inference, on basis he used it; and thesis markings on shells came from dry runs (i.e., his only 4 bullets ever?)
- Advocacy of single-missile theory regardless of actual size Connally back wound-- whether 1.2 or 3/5 inches.
- Benavides, witness closest to Tippit at shooting, failed ID LHO; but accepted IDs of Markham and others of highly dubious nature
- Contrived explanations of lack of match between Tippit bullets and shells found
- Evaluation of LHO/State Department transactions as "normal"
- Overriding importance attached to lost Bogard card
