At 10 a.m., Mr. M. W. GEORGE, 6769 Inverness Street, telephone TA 3-9729, office telephone LA 6-7268, advised he owns a few rent houses and apartments in Dallas, among them one located at 214 West Neeley Street, and that from April 1, 1963, to May 31, 1963, LEE HARVEY OSWALD resided upstairs at that address leaving on May 31, 1963, without notice. Mr. GEORGE stated since that time the apartment has been vacant and padlocked, however, he has reason to believe that within the past two months someone who had a key to the padlock has been going into the apartment, the reason being unknown to Mr. GEORGE.

Mr. GEORGE stated after OSWALD moved he completely cleaned the apartment and threw away all the trash on approximately June 2, 1963. He stated that since someone has been apparently using the apartment he thought the FBI might like to look through the apartment for possible scraps of evidence although he personally had done so on the evening of November 22, 1963, without finding anything of value.
