By communication dated March 11, 1964, the Bureau furnished the following information relative to State Department interviews of Mr. and Mrs. GEORGE and JEANNE DeMOHRENSCHILDT concerning a possible place of residence for LEE HARVEY OSWALD during the thirteen-day period between October 19, 1962, and November 2, 1962.

JEANNE DeMOHRENSCHILDT was interviewed by Mr. NORMAN E. WARNER, First Secretary of Embassy, Port-au-Prince, Haiti, on February 18, 1964, and furnished the following information:

Mrs. DeMOHRENSCHILDT stated she does not have the "slightest idea" where OSWALD went after leaving the YMCA. She stated she does not recall that she or her husband had any contact with OSWALD during the time he was at the YMCA. When the interviewing officer mentioned that MARINA OSWALD had been living with a Mrs. ELENA HALL about this time, Mrs. DeMOHRENSCHILDT suggested that she, Mrs. HALL, might be able to supply additional information.

Mrs. DeMOHRENSCHILDT stated she "vaguely remembers" that OSWALD was at the YMCA about the time period indicated, October 15-19, 1962, but she did not know when he had checked out of the YMCA.

Mrs. DeMOHRENSCHILDT thought OSWALD's stay at the YMCA must have been about the time when he thought he was going to lose his job in Fort Worth; he had accordingly gone to Dallas to look for employment. Mrs. DeMOHRENSCHILDT's recollection was vague regarding dates and the sequence of events. She recalled she had taken MARINA OSWALD to a dental clinic about September, 1962. When the interviewing officer mentioned that MARINA OSWALD had resided with Mr. and Mrs. TAYLOR and with Mrs. HALL in October, 1962, Mrs. DeMOHRENSCHILDT immediately clarified that MARINA OSWALD had stayed for only one night at the home of Mr. and Mrs. GARY TAYLOR and that this had been the night following the visit to the dentist. Mrs. DeMOHRENSCHILDT stated at this time (without prompting) that Mrs. TAYLOR was her husband's daughter.

JEANNE and GEORGE DeMOHRENSCHILDT were interviewed by Mr. NORMAN E. WARNER, First Secretary of Embassy, Port-au-Prince, Haiti, on March 2, 1964, and furnished the following information:

GEORGE DeMOHRENSCHILDT stated he did not know where OSWALD went after checking out of the YMCA. He stated this must have been the period when OSWALD was looking for a job in Dallas after having been "fired" from his job in Fort Worth. Mr. DeMOHRENSCHILDT speculated that OSWALD "probably stayed with some friends in Fort Worth - but nobody we know," after leaving the YMCA.

Mr. DeMOHRENSCHILDT stated he did not know when OSWALD moved into the YMCA and he does not recall having seen OSWALD while he was at the YMCA. GEORGE and JEANNE DeMOHRENSCHILDT stated they are "almost sure" that Mrs. OSWALD stayed during this period with "a girl of Russian origin married to an American dentist." They thought this "girl" had a "simple name" but could not recall the name. A short time later when Mr. WARNER mentioned that Mrs. OSWALD had resided with Mr. and Mrs. GARY TAYLOR and with a Mrs. ELENA HALL during October, 1962, Mr. DeMOHRENSCHILDT immediately exclaimed that Mrs. HALL was the person to whom he had been referring but whose name he had been unable to recall. Mr. DeMOHRENSCHILDT recalled that at about this time (he could not recall the date) he had been in Fort Worth on business and had dropped in to see Mrs. OSWALD at the HALLs' residence. He stated OSWALD was not there and Mrs. OSWALD had not mentioned where her husband was, at least so far as he could recall. Mr. DeMOHRENSCHILDT remarked that OSWALD was "separated or fighting with his wife" at this time.
