Synopsis: Ammunition dealers located at South Houston, Texas, and Victoria, Texas, who have handled 6.5 mm western ammunition but none familiar with OSWALD and none could recall selling ammunition to person meeting subject's description.

DETAILS:

On December 27, 1963, records of Sloan's Sporting Goods Company, 88 Chambers Street, New York, New York, were checked and disclosed a shipment of 6.5 mm western ammunition was made to the following consignees in the general area of Houston, Texas:

In October, 1963, 1,000 rounds of ammunition were shipped to Kenlee's, 706 Winkler, South Houston, Texas, under invoice number 4938.

In October, 1963, 1,000 rounds of this ammunition were shipped to Victoria Army Sales, 401 East Rio Grande, Victoria, Texas, under invoice number 112630.

The following investigation was conducted by SA TERENCE D. DUNAN at South Houston, Texas, on January 3, 1964:

KENNETH YOUNG, Kenlee's Gun Shop, 706 Winkler, verified the fact that in October, 1963, he received 1,000 rounds of 6.5 western ammunition from Sloan's Sporting
