RE: SALE OF 6.5 MM MANNLICHER-
CARCANO CARTRIDGES

On December 4, 1963, the Chicago Division advised GEORGE ZUCKER, Chicago Sales Representative, Century Arms Company, St. Albans, Vermont, on that date furnished the names of dealers to whom he had shipped 6.5 mm Mannlicher-Carcano cartridges originally manufactured by the Western Cartridge Corporation, East Alton, Illinois. Among various shipments handled by ZUCKER was one on December 7, 1962, of 20,000 rounds shipped to Western Trading Company, 4012 Griegs Road, Houston, Texas, which had been purchased from Sloan's Sporting Goods Company, Inc., 88 Chambers Street, New York, New York.

On December 13, 1963, HOWARD B. WALZER, President, Sloan's Sporting Goods, Inc., 88 Chambers Street, furnished a list of consignees to whom quantities of 6.5 mm cartridges had been shipped by Sloan's during the period April, 1962 - February, 1963. At this latter date the supply of these cartridges was depleted.

On December 16, 1963, the list of consignees was furnished to the Dallas Division.
