OIMEY, President, Century Arms, Inc., 54 Lake Street, St. Albans, Vermont, made available the invoices covering shipment of 6.5 mm. ammunition manufactured by Western Cartridge Corporation, which Century Arms handled in 1962 and 1963. Mr. OIMEY stated Century Arms has disposed of all such ammunition and has not shipped any orders since about August 1963.

All of the invoices were examined for the names of LEE HARVEY OSWALD, O. H. LEE, A. G. HIDEELL and A. J. HIDEELL. None of the invoices examined bore any of these names. It was noted that the invoices for 1962 showed approximately 200 individual orders were filled by Century Arms. The following shipments were noted as being sent to purchasers in Texas:
