Under date of December 5, 1963, the FBI Laboratory furnished the following information concerning an examination requested by the Dallas Office, under date of December 2, 1963:

Specimens received 12-3-63

Q105-Q170 Sixty-six 6.5 mm Mannlicher-Carcano cartridge cased from Sports Dome Gun Range, Dallas, Texas

Also Submitted: Two boxes of miscellaneous cartridge cases of other than 6.5 mm caliber

Results of examination:

Of the cartridge cases submitted, sixty-six were 6.5 mm Mannlicher-Carcano specimens. These are listed above as specimens Q105 through Q170. These cartridge cases were compared with the test cartridge cases obtained from the rifle, K1, previously submitted in this case. As a result of this examination, it was determined that none of the Q105 through Q170 cartridge cases could have been fired in specimen K1.

The rifle K1, referred to above, is the rifle recovered from the Texas School Book Depository, a 6.5 mm Mannlicher-Carcano rifle with telescopic sight with Serial Number C2766.
