Mrs JFK - posture lat
frame until 260-70

She watched crowd to right
or JFK.

(Hill reaction much later than
204 - - - Mrs H memory
seems incorrect

② At no time any marked change
posture head Mrs K.

II Gov. C. no evil he [223] turned
or was doing nothing but look
→ crowd at right, some for
Kellerman. Gov. Shoulds at 225-7
go left somewhat.

III Mrs JFK reaction to shot
starts about 223 - and Gov C
does seem react about 230-31

③ Gov in 229 while flare may be
beginning of hand reaction.

④ Amazing reaction time between
Gov C & JFK only $\frac{1}{3}$ second
apart.

⑤ Gov spit shoulder then dips
head in re Mrs K head
signif lower. Right turn seemed
man clutching himself fully right

⑦ No index words for JFK or Gore

⑧ CC felt if Gore hit in
222-5 had right shoulder
slightly to right - so while
reach time reports WC, position ^{not} _{proper}

⑩ Head shot, for angles of
up & down - slightly forward
A string of matter went
down straight up & then
→ road to left

⑪ In tracing trajectory, Gore ^{back-} chest
