Dear Sylvia,

Last night I scribbled off a letter to my peaker, and the last sentence had a message for you, but it was so cramped in that she may not be able to read it. How I hate about half an hour or so before Menaclen returns, so I'll get this brief note off to you. (Varda will take this to the P.O. on a shopping errand).

Menaclen is planning to leave for the States before the end of this month!!! He has written to Max Geismar in Harrison, N.Y., so if you wish to know his feelings now, you could find out from Max by just a casual phone call. Please, don't let it be known you know about me. And do let me know your opinion. He has also written several letters to affluent people for financial support. He has so far been promised \$6,000 from one source. He says he needs \$20,000. The printer has agreed to work with him, and he can pay off the part debt as he goes along. He plans to leave Varda and me here until he has T.H.O. on the road again.

A letter to you should involve me for several hours, and it would even be important for me, but so far that has been impossible. Even now, I'm so nervous as I'm writing that my entire body is trembling. I will try, as soon as possible, to bring you up to date. To put it in a nut shell — some days are absolutely better than can be expected, and some days are absolutely hell on earth. I may have to make a decision as to our (Varda's + mine) future in the very next few days.

Please, write a casual, non-knowing letter to me at this address. I must see his reaction

Paul does not yet know about his return. Please don't
tell her. Also, please don't tell her anything upsetting -
I cannot take her hysterical letters now.

I must close now. Will try to write again - ask
more details soon.
