Your many articles re the Warren report have been read with great interest.

From shortly after the investigation was started I wrote the Commission plus Senator (Attorney General) Kennedy suggesting that they look into all details of the employment of Oswald.

I happen to be engaged in personnel work so thought it strange that a book depository representing such publishers as McGraw Hill etc would be so careless in employment procedures -

Our family felt so strongly that something was wrong with the entire investigation that we drove to Dallas a couple of summers ago to see the spot - Our children (teens) wanted to see for themselves - Seeing the imposing list of publishers represented by the Depository and the location of the building gives one the

feeling that it was all set up -
Almost anyone could hit a target
moving along street in front of the
building and then you add the little
park and railroad bridge - It
would be hard to find an easier
spot.

Were the employment records of
the depository carefully checked,
did Oswald fill out the same
forms as any other applicant,
were his references checked
etc etc - This might be
an avenue worth checking -

Your articles are doing a great
service and I hope you and the
Minority of one keep up the good
investigation - The challenge to
the report is vital for we must
learn the truth in order to know what
does go on in our county today -
