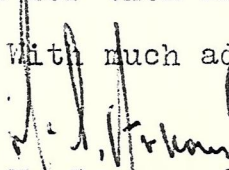
My dear Mrs. Field:

Had there existed only one such challenger, the immoral vulgar pragmatists might have won the philosophical debate; but so long as there exists more than one such challenger, so long as each such challenge is joined in, or applauded by, at least one additional person, the human potential for not self-serving decency is borne out.

So I must tell you that your own work as well as your generous praise of me are not only deeply appreciated by me, but constitute part of that affirmative dialogue that gives merit to our exertions and philosophy.
