Dear Vince,

After talking to Livvie last night I sent the enclosed wire to David Welsh at Ramparts. I am sending you this copy for your information.

I am sorry that Jones is on to this, as well as Ramparts, presumably thanks to the same source.

But the only important thing now is to compel the public to examine the facts you have uncovered and their implications. As I told Livvie last night, I will do anything in my power that may be needed and can provide some money if that is short.

If TMO puts out a special issue, perhaps Mr. Arnoni would consider devoting the whole issue to the same subject. There is plenty of material ready to be published--Stamm has some good stuff, Dave Lifton's "Dialogue" is probably available, and several parts of my manuscript can be used as independent articles. If you find any value in this suggestion, I leave it to you to raise it with Mr. Arnoni.

Vince, would it be possible for me to see a copy of your article, in strict confidence and purely for my own eyes? After what has happened this week, I hesitate to ask you. There seem to be few people around who can be trusted.

One other point--ever since you told me about your finding I have been thinking how much it will mean to the mother and to Robert O. He did seem to have feeling for his brother and did for a while resist the enormous pressure to concur in the lone-assassin-thesis. Do you think they can be told that conclusive evidence has been found, without specifying what it is?
