Dear Mr. Gates:

Your letter of February 20th contains misstatements of fact. Mr. Arnoni's appearance on the Mort Sahl program was not incidental to a lecture tour, but his lecture tour was incidental to his appearance on the Mort Sahl program. That's why no forum other than your program was asked to pay for Mr. Arnoni's travel expenses.

Contrary to your allegation, the commitment to pay for Mr. Arnoni's travel expenses has been re-stated by the producer and others many times, long before and immediately before Mr. Arnoni's arrival in Los Angeles as well as during his stay there, including intermissions in the course of the broadcast itself.

You are, of course, fully aware of the above. Your pretense to the contrary is in keeping with a decision you had conveyed to your associates that, because of your disapproval of Mr. Arnoni's ideas, you would renege on your financial commitment to him.

It is likely that had you been aware how fully we are able to substantiate the facts, you would not have exposed yourself to an embarrassment such as becomes probable when one sends off a collection of falsehoods like your letter of February 20th.
