Dear Mr. Wilson:

Thank you for your letter of March 31. As you requested, I am enclosing a copy of my memo of March 24, 1975 on the CIA and the Warren Commission, which I submitted to the Rockefeller Commission and later to the Church and Pike Committees. I am also enclosing a recent article from the Saturday Evening Post which supplements the information on page 19 of the memo.

Thank you for the less sanitized version of CIA Item 448, and for the information you provided about the appearance of the phrase "agency official." As I noted in my letter of March 17, as originally released this document contains the allegation that David Belin and Robert Olsen of the Rockefeller Commission were CIA officials. I suggested that a formal confirmation or denial was called for. Your letter refers to "errors" in the sanitized version, but does not specifically comment on the implication that Belin and Olsen were CIA employees. The insertion and release of the phrase "agency official" would certainly be a clerical error whether or not that description was accurate. I understand that Belin has already denied that he was a CIA employee. To clarify the record, I would like to suggest again that you state whether or not Belin or Olsen were CIA officials, detailees, or otherwise CIA employees during their service on the Rockefeller Commission.
