On December 31, 1963, Chief ALTO ALBUSCHAT, Villa Park Police Department, Villa Park, Illinois, advised SA RUDOLPH E. MANCINI that BOB NEWTON, formerly of 510 Monterey Street, Villa Park, Illinois, and employed by Sears-Roebuck Company, Chicago, was transferred by Sears to Dallas, Texas in October of 1963. NEWTON currently employed as a regional manager at Dallas and resides on Camelot Street.

He said NEWTON returned to Villa Park for a visit around December 23, 1963 and advised ALBUSCHAT in a casual conversation that his neighbor in Dallas, Texas whom he did not identify, informed him that her brother is a Lincoln-Mercury dealer in Dallas and that this neighbor stated that her brother informed her that OSWALD had purchased a 1963 Lincoln from his agency and was to pick up the car on the day of the assassination of President KENNEDY, November 22, 1963.

NEWTON also advised ALBUSCHAT there is a Lincoln-Mercury dealer located in Dallas near the theater where OSWALD was apprehended subsequent to the assassination of President KENNEDY.

ALBUSCHAT stated that NEWTON is a white male, approximately 35 years of age, married, and is considered to be a reliable, trustworthy person of good reputation.
