ROBERT C. NEWTON, advised he lives at 3356 Camelot and his home telephone number is FL. 2-9329. He stated he is employed by Sears at their Buying Office, 1409 South Lamar in Dallas. Texas.

He advised that he and his wife, DORIS, were visited by a greeters' group from the Walnut Hill Lutheran Church recently and one couple in the group whose identity he did not know, advised them that a brother of the visiting couple had heard that a Lincoln-Mercury Agency on Jefferson Street near the theater in Oak Cliff, had sold LEE HARVEY OSWALD a Lincoln Continental. They reported he bought this car cash and it was to have been delivered on November 22 or 23, 1963.

The couple stated the FBI was aware of this and was "on OSWALD's track like a suit of clothes".

Mr. NEWTON advised that his wife DORIS was away from Dallas visiting her family in Chicago, Illinois and attending the funeral of an aunt there. He said she would return to Dallas late Thursday evening and would be available for interview on Friday, January 3, 1964. He said there was no way to contact her by telephone in Chicago.

He said he had never known LEE HARVEY OSWALD or JACK RUBY and knew of no association between them.
