Mrs. DORIS (ROBERT C.) NEWTON, 3356 Camelot, Dallas, Texas, advised a Mr. and Mrs. VICTOR ANDERSON, members of the Walnut Hill Lutheran Church greeters' group, visited she and her husband shortly after the assassination of President KENNEDY on November 22, 1963, and Mrs. ANDERSON advised she had a relative who worked for a Lincoln-Mercury dealership that is located near the theater where LEE HARVEY OSWALD was apprehended, and this relative had advised her that OSWALD bought a 1964 Lincoln Continental to be delivered on November 22, 1963.

She said Mrs. ANDERSON told her the FBI had already been there and questioned the dealer soon after OSWALD was caught. Mrs. NEWTON said that Reverend G. DUANE JOHNSON, the Pastor of the Walnut Hill Lutheran Church, lived at 3126 Catamore, and the church was located at 3202 Royal Lane, and he would probably be able to advise the address of the ANDERSONS. She said she had never known LEE HARVEY OSWALD or JACK RUBY and she knew of no relationship between them.
