L. G. HERRINGTON, 7207 Hazel Road, Dallas, Texas, telephone number EX. 1-5185, advised he had worked for the downtown Lincoln-Mercury dealership until December 30, 1963 as a new car get ready man. He said his immediate supervisor was TKE HUSKINS. He said about a week after President JOHN F. KENNEDY was assassinated, HUSKINS told him he heard a salesman state that OSWALD had been there and had tried to make a deal for a car, and advised that he would return in a week or two as he was going to come into some money.

Mr. HERRINGTON said this conversation took place at Glen's Drive-in which is located on Industrial Avenue about one block south of Commerce Street in Dallas, Texas, and said he seemed to recall that DALE TENNILL, another employee of downtown Lincoln-Mercury, might have been in the tavern when this conversation took place.

He said that it was the custom of people in the "get ready department" to drop into the tavern after work for a couple of beers. He was unable to recall that anyone else was present when HUSKINS made these remarks.

He said he had no personal knowledge of OSWALD or RUBY or the clubs operated by RUBY in Dallas, and he knew of no association between OSWALD and RUBY; however, he said he had heard the FBI had been out to interview employees of downtown Lincoln-Mercury. He said he believed HUSKINS was still employed there.
