

company that LAWRENCE was driving the car for, and LAWRENCE was unable to establish this but said he would pick up the car on the street and drive it from there, and this in turn caused him (ROZZELL) to telephone the FBI and report his observations of LAWRENCE's behavior.

Mr. ROZZELL said that a salesman named BOGARD and Mr. PIZZO had furnished information to the FBI re contemplated purchase of a "Comet" by a person believed to be identical with LEE HARVEY OSWALD, and two pairs of Agents had interviewed Mr. BOGARD concerning this.

He advised that the city Lincoln-Mercury dealership had been out of business in Dallas since about 1960 or 1961, and he said he had no information concerning LEE HARVEY OSWALD or JACK RUBY.
