CHARLES FRANKLIN HUSKINS advised he is also known as "IKE" HUSKINS and lives at 105 Mirven in Waxahachie, Texas, telephone number WE. 7-3678. He said he has been employed for one and one-half years prior to December 31, 1963 as a shop foreman at the Downtown Lincoln-Mercury dealership in Dallas, Texas. He said he recalled the new car sales personnel talking on November 22, 1963 about the assassination of President KENNEDY. This discussion took place about 2:30 or 3:00 P.M. on November 22, 1963 and one of the salesmen, FRED FALZONE (PH), had remarked "a man (OSWALD) was in here trying to buy a car". He said that on that evening or possibly a day or so later, he met L. G. HERRINGTON and DALE TENNILL at Glen's Drive-In where they had a couple of beers and he mentioned this discussion to them and said he believed it was a Mercury that OSWALD tried to buy.

He said he never heard OSWALD actually making a trade or taking a demonstration ride. He said that he did not believe that he had ever told anyone that the FBI had made inquiry at Downtown Lincoln-Mercury concerning the attempt by OSWALD to buy a car, and that no person from the FBI has interviewed him before in connection with this matter.

He said he had no knowledge of OSWALD or RUBY or their possible association prior to the assassination of President KENNEDY and had never been in the Carousel or the Vegas Club at any time.
