DALE TENNILL advised he resides at 4034 Walker in Dallas, Texas and has been employed by the Downtown Lincoln-Mercury automobile dealership at 118 Commerce Street for about 18 months and he is presently assigned to the new car "make ready" department. He said he recalls going to Glen's Drive-In about a week after President KENNEDY was assassinated, with "IKE" HUSKINS and L. G. HERRINGTON, also known as "RED", and at that time IKE remarked he had heard that LEE HARVEY OSWALD had tried to buy a new car from the dealership. He said he did not recall whether it was a Lincoln or a Mercury, but somehow or other believed it must have been a "Comet". He said it was the custom of employees in the "make ready" and maintenance department to drop by Glen's Drive-In for a beer after work, but so much time had passed that he was unable to recall definitely what the conversation was between HUSKINS and HERRINGTON and himself.

He said he had no knowledge of OSWALD or RUBY prior to the assassination of President KENNEDY and knew of no association between OSWALD and RUBY.

He said he had never heard AL BOGARD, a salesman for Downtown Lincoln Mercury, discuss the fact that he (BOGARD) had been approached by LEE HARVEY OSWALD concerning the purchase of a new Comet prior to the assassination of President KENNEDY. He did remark that BOGARD has bought a beer joint known as "The Bent Elbow", which is located at 3210 Pacific Avenue in Dallas, Texas, in the past few days.
