Miss Meagher —

I must write a hasty letter — please excuse.

Here is a bit of information that may help you to confirm your suspicion of collusion between Kovelody and Shelley whose testimony conflicts with that of Victoria Adams.

Outline of Adams movements:

ran down back stairs within $1\frac{1}{2}$ minutes of shooting — did not see or hear Oswald
saw Kovelody and Shelley on first floor
ran outside to railroad yards
came back to TSBD.

Here is what she says happened after she returned from railroad yard, but before she re-entered TSBD (6H391):

"There was a motorcycle that was parked on the corner of Houston and Elm... I paused to listen to the report on the police radio, and they said that shots had been fired which apparently came either from the second floor or the fourth floor window..."

Questioned whether she had not heard "second floor from the top", she said:

"It said second floor."

Here is transcript of police radio log (Sawyer
Exhibit A - 21H391):

12:38 (time)... "A witness says he saw 'em pull
the weapon from the window off the
second floor on the south east
corner of the Depository building"
(there is a reference to the fourth floor
a few lines below (on p. 392), but I
don't have a verbatim note on that —
you may check it).

Is this enough to put the lie on the Commission's
assertion that Adams came down the back stairs
about 10 minutes after the shooting?
