**N.O. Death Case
Is Under Probe**

The Orleans parish coroner's office Tuesday placed under investigation the death of Robert Perrin, 41, 1713 Calhoun.

Perrin died in Charity hospital at 6 a. m. State police said a man believed to have been Perrin called them at 1:25 a. m. and said: "I need help quick. Please send me an ambulance."

State police Sgt. Lashley Boudreaux contacted New Orleans police, and Second District Sgt. Charles Guedner and Ptn. Sanford Krasnoff were sent to the Calhoun address. The officers said they found Perrin in bed with several empty ether cans nearby.
