Dear Mr. Podhoretz.

Your editorial on the Warren Commission in the January 1964 issue made a powerful impression, contrasting as it did with the almost universal timidity of the press and the general reluctance to encourage any doubts about the official case or the Presidential Commission. Now that the long-awaited Warren Report has finally been issued and there has been an opportunity to study it with extreme vigilance, I find that my original doubts about Oswald's guilt have only been compounded. The enclosed article is a critique on the Warren Report, based largely on its internal contradictions and the emission of vital information. I take the liberty of sending it for consideration, in the hope that you will find it a responsible analysis of some of the defects in the Report and regard it as necessary to bring those defects before the public.
