I am enclosing a city map of Dallas and as soon as I find out anything I'll let you know immediately. By the way thanks very much for the booklet you sent me - I found it very interesting.

It was great seeing you after all this time although much too brief - I hope I can afford another trip in February and we'll plan to spend more time together. My personal complications are no longer complicated which is more than a relief. Sometimes I think I am going a little crackers by allowing myself these involvements but they always start out as such fun and then end up a big drag.

Hope you are well and I know you are busy so when you can find the time you know I always enjoy hearing from you. How is Alex? ^Have you seen him recently? Also please give Carrie my love
