As a student of the Oswald case for a year, I still remember your fine article in the London Observer on 1 December 1963 on your interviews in Dallas with persons involved in the case. I wonder if the London Observer has published any comment on the Warren Report and, if so, whether I might be able to borrow a copy? I have prepared a 15,000-word analysis of serious defects in the Warren Report and would be pleased to let you see a copy if you have any interest in it personally or for possible use in your newspaper.
