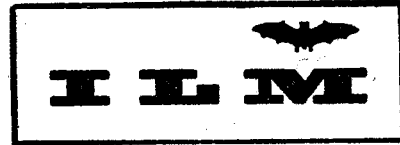

Dear Miss Meagher,



I doubt very much whether we could interest a British publisher at the moment.

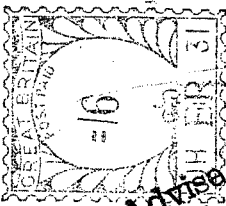

I am very sorry not to be more helpful, but I would appreciate receiving your further views.

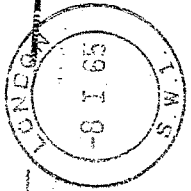
