We have now studied the material you sent us about the Oswald case." "Several books have already been announced on the subject and there is always danger with a topical book of this kind of it ceasing to be topical by the time it ean be published.

I doubt very much whether we could interest a British publisher at the moment.

If you can get the book commissioned in the United States first, then chances here would undoubtedly increase. I know you pointed out the difficulties in America, but surely it would be worth your while to have a good try before embarking on a first draft, which you say would take you 6 to 9 months at least. This seems to me a great risk for you to take, without a near certainty of publication.
