Over the last four years I have had some ten or more articles and review-essays published in various periodicals, all dealing with the assassination of President Kennedy, the Warren Report, and closely related events (the assassinations of Martin Luther King and Robert F. Kennedy, the Garrison "investigation", etc.).

It has often occurred to me that it would be useful to other researchers and critics, and perhaps interesting to the public at large, if a collection of these magazine pieces was reprinted in book form--preferably as an inexpensive paperback.

I am enclosing a list of the articles with dates, publications in which they appeared, and title or subject matter in each case, as well as estimated numbers of words. Key articles by other writers and critics perhaps would also be available for reprinting in such a collection.

Do you think that the idea has any merit? If so, and if Bobbs-Merrill is not itself able to consider such a project, can you suggest other houses that might be interested? As you know, there is a "hard core" of collectors who acquire anything that is published that deals with JFK and/or with the Dallas assassination, and while I do not know the size of this group it is my impression that none of the books published on the subject have failed to sell reasonably well--although I may be mistaken on that score.

In any case, if and when you have a moment, I would greatly value your advice and suggestions.
