

Re the Carcano in question: The rear sling keeper (or swivel) is recessed into the left side of the butt and would be almost impossible to mislocate inadvertantly. The forward swivel could (or might) be installed up-side-down, but this would require the sling itself to cross the underside of the gun from one side to the other. It would be easier for me to show this to you than to try and prose it.
