Thank you for your inquiry about our Sept. 28 Periscope item "Washington, D.C." Dr. Vincent P. Guinn who is director of neutron-activation analysis at the General Atomic Division of the General Dynamics Corporation described this detection system to the scientists and observers attending the 10-day U.N. Atoms-for-Peace Conference held a month ago in Geneva. As you have probably learned by now, the Warren commission report revealed that the neutron-activation analysis had been tried but had not succeeded in establishing anything. Nevertheless, we are enclosing a copy of a clipping from the New York Times which describes what can be achieved by using this system.
