It was the worst of all possible Sundays for CBS News to open a four-part inquiry into the controversy over the Warren Commission Report on the assassination of President Kennedy. With its own scientific studies of available film, CBS supported the Warren Report in its basic finding that Lee Harvey Oswald shot Mr. Kennedy. For starters, commentator Walter Cronkite said CBS was merely drawing a distinction between "Oswald as a killer and Oswald as the killer." Tonight, said Cronkite, the inquiry will go into the question of whether there was another assassin at work. Critical evaluation of the CBS investigation is reserved.
