



On The Air

In the second chapter last night of its four-part inquiry into the controversy over the Warren Commission Report on the slaying of President Kennedy, CBS News concluded that Lee Harvey Oswald was the "sole assassin."

Navy Capt. James J. Humes, who performed the autopsy, said the shots that wounded and then killed the President came from the rear. "There is not a single item of hard evidence for a second assassin," said reporter Walter Cronkite. CBS News, in its Warren Commission inquiry, is making a mockery of all the small-time TV talk-shows which featured the book-selling critics of the Warren Report.

Such intensive network TV interest in the contents of the Warren Commission Report may be tardy. But CBS thus far is making much more sense out of it all on the somescreen than anyone has bothered to do before.
