Dear Menachen,

If it is not too late to make a change in the review of the CBS "documentary," please delete the last sentence of paragraph one on page 9 ("They had not been received at press time.") and insert the following:

CBS replied that it would not be possible to provide the requested information because of its "long-standing policy prohibiting the release of any research material, notes, reportage or interviews gathered in connection with any program except that material which appears on the air." So certain was it that CBS would refuse to disclose the condition of the test bullets that the refusal was already indicated in the manuscript of this review, awaiting only the official CBS corroboration received two weeks later.

I am so glad that CBS did not let me down! I would have wagered a month's salary that they would not agree to give me the data requested.

If it is not any trouble, I would appreciate having the address of Ray Marcus, on the letter which you read to me on the telephone; also, if you have it, the address of Eric Norden.
