If it is not too late to make a change in the review of the CES "documentary," please delete the last sentence of paragraph one on page 9 ("They had not been received at press time.") and insert the following:

CBS replied that it would not be possible to provide
the requested information because of its long-standing
policy prohibiting the release of any research material,
notes, reportage or interviews gathered in connection
with any program except that material which appears on
the air. So certain was it that GBS would refuse
to disclose the condition of the test bullets that the
refusal was already indicated in the manuscript of this
review, awaiting only the official CBS corroboration
received two weeks later.

I am so glad that CBS did not let me down: I would have wagered a month's salary that they would not agree to give me the data i requested.
