Dear Sylvia:

Enclosed are copies of various unpublished materials dealing with various aspects of the Walker group as I mentioned in my letter of March 1. CD 1543 is the only one of these which had been withheld prior to the recent declassification, but they are all interesting. As regards the Hosty/Surrey relationship, I am intrigued by the fact that aside from the German newspaper scoop (see CD 1543), the only other agency to suspect Oswald's role in the Walker shooting attempt, prior to Marina's revelations on December 3, 1963, was the FBI itself -- see CE 2524, p. 2. Since the German newspaper claims that Walker himself supplied the allegation, according to the FBI's "confidential" informant, everything seems to point to some kind of Walker-FBI rapprochement.

There are numerous other oddities throughout this material, a few of which I have noted marginally. I shall be interested to hear your reactions.

No need to return these. We'll be more than repaid to have the benefit of your knowledge and analysis in interpreting this material.
