## Dear Mr. Eckhoff:

Thank you for your letter of August 2, concerning my request for the copy of the pamphlet "The Crime Against Cuba" which was made available to SA John L. Quigley of the FBI by Lee Harvey Oswald. I greatly appreciate your efforts to locate this item for me. At this time I am not asking you to make any further checks, but I would like some clarification of certain points.

You wrote that "none of the original panphlets which we received from the F.B.I. bears any identification which would indicate that it is the pamphlet given to Agent Quigley by Oswald." If this refers to any copies other than those mentioned in my letter of June 24 (CD 1495, which is CE 3120, and FBI Exhibits 99 and 303), please advise, and send me a copy of pages 38, 39, and 40 of each such additional pamphlet.

In my letter of June 24, I asked you to inquire at the Justice Department concerning a check of FBI files for this pamphlet which that Department had previously made at my request. Your reply does not mention this point. I would like to know if you made such an inquiry; and, if so, whether you obtained any information that might be of use to me in locating this pamphlet. If you felt it inappropriate to check with the Justice Department on my behalf, please let me know.
