Dear Mrs. Meagher:

I hate to trouble you except I know you might like to be apprised of "Warren Report" material in obscure publications.

This publication crossed my desk -- ATLAS -- printed in New York, as a "digest" of world opinion, and reprints an article on pp 10 (also see note inside front cover) from "Special", Brussels for Jan. 12, 1967.

If you cared to read the article (please eventually return themagazine) I wondered if you can tell me whether there is anything in the Warren Commission Report, Hearings, or Exhibits, that bear at all upon the story, so that our men can research it.

The date of the alleged J. Edgar Hoover letter to the anonymous seaman, appears to me to be too late for it to be included in the Warren Report, but unless this facsimile is a phony photostat, I suppose it could be traced to the FBI and SS, and the sailor's name disclosed.

Are there any other "pre-assassination" warnings to the U. S. agencies, besides ~~xxx~~ Gongora's letter, appearing in the record?

(I never received your response re Joesten)\$. I hope I haven't lost it before opening.
