Dear Mrs. Meagher:

I received your letter + summary today and read it with great interest. I still do not have time to write you fully but I do want to compare notes with you.

I read about the course at the New School for Social Research in New York and wished so much at the time that some sort of the same thing would be offered out here.

Mr. Carson wrote that he was going on vacation on April 15 so if you wish to contact him, do so before he leaves. Please note the dates on my correspondence — it is interesting that I haven't changed my views from that time and I, too, have <sup>read</sup> everything I could get my hands on regarding the assassination. "The Gaps in the Warren Report" — \$1.00 — Marzani & Munsell is a supplement to J. J. Fester's <sup>original</sup> book and in the second <sup>and third</sup> paragraph of page 178 and in the last paragraph of page 179 he mentions ~~the points~~ my views stated in my first letter to the Warren Commission on April 14, 1964. Mine is the "copy of a letter sent to the Warren Commission on April 14".

This is the first time that storm drain has been mentioned in print even though Buchanan wrote to me about it — after I had sent him the file of my correspondence — and I sent him a lot of material thinking he would mention it in the American edition of his book — but he checked out.
