December 15, 1964

Beginning in the early part of April, I started sending you and others copies of correspondence and various exhibits that I had sent to the Warren Commission regarding serious doubts and speculations regarding the assassination of the President.

The Commission Report which was to quell all doubts and answer all speculations has now been released. And, if you read my former communications to you, you know that the report did not even remotely touch upon or answer in any small detail, my doubts and speculations.

I send you herewith the details of another peculiar discrepancy which I believe to be quite interesting.

If you are interested in my sending you any further peculiar points of interest, I should appreciate an answer to this letter.

I wish someone would give me a good reason why, for the good of my country, I should deny the evidence of my own eyes and ears, and keep my mouth shut.
