Bertrand Russell answered, personally. The Nation & Saturday Evening Post returned the statements. The National Guardian answered with thanks. An associate editor of Newsweek (who later didn't answer when I sent some more material) answered. And, belatedly, The Minority of One included an edited version of the statement in their March, 1965, Letters to the Editor. That's all. Four answers out of thirty sent.

But no one gave me any reason at all to keep my mouth shut for the good of my country.
