On November 25, 1963, Assistant ^{To TAC} Director A. H. BELMONT advised Inspector JAMES R. MALLEY that the Associated Press in New York had a photograph that bore the number on the bottom: "FK 61345 STP," with the note, "Editor, this is a blowup of DN 2, making images larger DN 5, Dallas, Texas, 11/22."

According to Mr. BELMONT, in this photograph there was a man who appeared to be standing in the doorway of the Texas School Book Depository who resembled OSWALD.
