JIMMY LEE McINTIRE, Assistant to the Manager, Oneal Incorporated, Funeral Directors, 3206 Oak Lawn Avenue, advised that on November 22, 1963, at 12:19 p.m. they received a call to make an ambulance pickup of an injured person at 100 N. Houston Street, Dallas, Texas. McINTIRE stated ambulance No. 606 made the call; the driver was AUBREY LEE RIKE, and the attendant was DENNIS McGUIRE.

McINTIRE said the patient's name was JERRY B. BELKNAP, 1212 Ross Drive, Irving, Texas. McINTIRE said when this ambulance arrived at Parkland Hospital there was much confusion since President KENNEDY had at about the same time also arrived at Parkland Hospital. He advised that in the resulting confusion BELKNAP, who did not seem to be seriously injured, walked away without ever signing in at the hospital. McINTIRE stated that on December 2, 1963, BELKNAP paid his ambulance bill of \$12.50.
