Dear Ed,

Thanks for returning the Harold Feldman article and the other material, which arrived this morning.

Ed, my press-clipping service is four-fifths exhausted and will probably expire before the end of this month. It is too expensive for me to contemplate renewal. As you know, the charges are \$180 for 1000 clippings, as compared to the usual rate of \$250 for 1000.

If you, or Viking, would like to obtain the same service, you could make arrangements with Mr. Lipton, American Press Clipping Service, Inc., 119 Nassau Street, NY, NY 10038. My arrangement was for all stories dealing with the Warren Report or the assassination of JFK, which would automatically include stories on Inquest but also has covered other books and news reports on Ruby, Marina Oswald, and other principals in the case or on the Commission. Flocks of stories on Marina or Ruby, largely repetitious, have of course served to speed the exhaustion of the service. You might wish to narrow the subject; but the danger of a narrower classification is that you would not receive many stories of interest or importance if they did not happen to mention your name.

I thought I should mention this to you so that if you wish to obtain the service there would not be any substantial gap between the expiration of my entitlement and the initiation of yours. I am sending a copy of this letter to Aaron Asher for his information.
