The xerox was not accessible to me, so I have typed out portions of Thornley's letter. As you know, I have not obtained consent to give you these excerpts but I feel sure that Thornley could have no objection, since they are to be used on his behalf in resisting transparently false and contrived charges.

At the same time, I think you should not quote directly from this letter, and I depend on you to use it with discretion.

I am also making available to you material I have received from David Lifton, on the understanding that he authorized you to obtain this material from me during your telephone conversation with him of Monday 5/27/68.

When I receive the Garrison press release on the temporaryrrestraining order, I will send you a copy. (If he does send it, that is.)
