Thanks very much for your letter of the 28th and for your very interesting notes on your interview of Epstein. I was especially interested in your discussion of the inscribed photograph of Oswald which surfaced in Epstein's book and earlier in a Dutch-language book by Oltmans. Now I find that this inscribed photo is discussed also in MARINA AND LEE, a book which I had not intended to bother with but which I ran out and bought this morning to see what Marina/Priscilla had to say about it.

What Priscilla says is so interesting that I copied it out of the book and enclose the excerpts herewith, for your information. Serious and obvious questions clearly arise from her account of how the inscribed photo was discovered, which you will easily see for yourself. I do suspect that we are dealing again with forged and planted "evidence" intended to shore up Oswald's alleged guilt as the lone assassin.

Incidentally, in the copy of the inscribed photo which comes out of Oltmans' book there is no sketch of a terrier under the Russian inscription!!

David, if it is no trouble, will you please send me a copy of the <u>Phoenix</u> containing your review of Epstein's book? I am eager to see it and I am sure that it will be incisive and valuable.
