Seriously, it was an excellent article.

I always make a big show of "buying them out" whenever they print anything on the assassination. I write to the publishers and editors and thank them for continuing to "try" to bring the truth out into the open. I have several news-stands in Dallas now accepting some magazines and papers only when there is an article on the assassination or periphery subjects.

My tentative plans now are that I will be off from work from the 7th of August until the 24th of August. And, there is the possibility that I won't have to return to the office until the first of September. My "boss" is leaving the 31st of August for La Jolla, California, and says he will return on the 21st of August. He never does what he says he is going to do and he usually spends the whole month out there, so I told him to phone me when he gets back to Dallas and I'll come back to the office. I have to stay in the office the first week of August because of "loose ends" I have to handle for him.
