

Excerpt from a letter from Dr. Cyril Wecht, dated 4 September 1970

With regard to the Oswald autopsy report, I cannot tell you whether the Rh factor is routinely determined and listed in Dallas autopsy reports. I can tell you that our Office and other medical-legal investigative offices with which I am familiar do not make Rh determinations unless it is a relevant and essential scientific issue in a particular case. Whether or not its absence from the Oswald autopsy report is significant depends on the validity of the Dallas critic's statement that such a determination is routinely and uniformly made in autopsies done by the Dallas Medical Examiner's Office.
