Dear Senator Murphy-

As one of your constituents, I urge you to look into the matter of President Kennedy's assassination - for, once having really acquainted yourself with the testimonies of the witnesses, the omissions of important evidence, and the conclusions of the Warren Commission which do not reflect the evidence contained in the 26 volumes, you will become as convinced as I am (and as are countless other students of the case) that the American public has not been told the truth about the circumstances of the President's murder.

The urgency of this request is occasioned by the suspicion that our policies - both foreign and domestic - may well hang in the balance. Thus, this is not a matter which can be set aside for future examination; it must be dealt with now.

Having read and studied the 26 volumes of Hearings, Testimony, and Exhibits carefully and thoroughly, I can assure you that the conclusions of the Warren Commission do not reflect the evidence.

You can be assured of my support (as well as that of many others) if you pursue this matter at once.
