During the course of the investigation in instant matter, various members of the Dallas Cinema Associates, Inc., Dallas, Texas, were interviewed, as reflected on pages 4 through 59 of the report of SA ROBERT P. GEMBERLING dated May 28, 1964. Among such persons interviewed was Mrs. IRVING GEWERTZ, 6422 Walnut Hill Lane, Dallas, Texas, who advised that she had been in contact with various people along the route of the Presidential motorcade and learned that PHIL WILLIS, 2824 Ava Lane, Dallas, Texas, had witnessed, with his wife and daughter, the assassination of President JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY and had taken still photographs of the Presidential motorcade in the vicinity of the Texas School Book Depository.

Mrs. GEWERTZ also stated that she had learned that C. B. ASHMORE, 4421 Hyer Street, Dallas, Texas, had taken still photographs somewhere in the vicinity of the Trade Mart, Dallas, Texas.
